

**CITIZEN CHARTER**

J&K State Agro Industries Development Corporation was incorporated in 1970 under Company's Act 1956 with Tractor Hiring and land reclamation as main activity.

**1. Vision and Mission Statement:-**

**VISION:-**

To provide post harvest infrastructure, quality agriculture inputs, machinery and marketing support to farmers with reasonable profit margins for the Corporation.

**MISSION:-**

1. Creating of Cold Stores, C.A. Stores, Warehouses, for storing of Agriculture products.
2. Provide High quality Agriculture, Inputs and Machinery to farmers.
3. Provide marketing support to farmers for their Agriculture/Horticulture products with economic viability for Corporation.
4. To make the Corporation financially viable.

The Organization is registered in the Company's Act 1956 as a Govt. Company working under the Ministry of Agriculture Production, "Govt. of Jammu and Kashmir". The executive body of the Corporation is Board of Directors which constitutes Members/Directors from State Govt. as well as from Govt. of India

The day today affairs of the company are being managed by Managing Director who is Executive Head of the organization. Managing Director functions through team of officers heading various business units and sections/departments. Each of the business unit is supervised by General Manager/Divisional Manager who report to Managing Director. The finance matters are looked after by Director Finance who also report to Managing Director. The Administration Section which includes the Board Section is supervised by Divisional Manager Administration who reports to Managing Director. Besides one General Manager Head Quarter monitors all the divisions.

The divisions have their own sections like Accounts Section, Administration Section, Production Section etc. which are looked after by divisional level Accountant, Section Officer/Jr. Asstt Head asstt. and Foreman etc.

The organizational chart showing the functional hierarchy is enclosed herewith.

## Details of Business transacted by the Organization:-

### **1. Functions:**

1. Production and Marketing of Cattle Feed.
2. Processing of various food products like jams, honey and Kashmiri Wazwan etc.
3. Marketing of Dry Fruits saffron, Olive Oil and other local Agricultural produce especially pulses etc.
4. Trading of Agricultural Machinery.
5. Trading of various types of fertilizers (chemical and Bio-Fertilizers)
6. Cold Storage and warehouse at Delhi.

### **2. Activities**

#### **1. Cold Storage Plant at Delhi.**

Corporation has a 4000 Mts. Cold Storage Plant at Delhi which was established in 1970's. The plant is under modernization.

#### **2. Cattle Feed Plant**

Corporation established a Cattle Feed Plant at Baribrahmana Jammu, during 1989 with 550 Mts. Capacity per day. The plant also needs modernization. The proposal for has been prepared and is being sent to Administrative Department for approval and funding.

### **3. Canning & Processing Division Khonmoh.**

Corporation established a Food Processing Division during 1981 at Khonmoh where honey and jams besides different canned products including Kashmiri Wazwan are being processed. The Division is being modernized and so far an amount of Rs. 125.11 lacs has been spent on renovation of the Plant Building and two Sales Centers. The unit is being equipped with modernized machines as well.

### **Procurement and Sales Division**

Corporation has two such Divisions one each at Jammu and Srinagar. The Division is engaged in trading of various Agriculture machinery, Fertilizer and Inputs etc. Besides this Jammu Division is also operating a Petrol Pump at Baribrahmana.

### **3. Details of the clients and details of services/goods provided to each client group.**

Corporation generally deals with following clients for its business.

1. Director Agriculture, Jammu/Srinagar. For supply of Agri. Machinery & Inputs
2. Director Horticulture/Jammu/Srinagar. For supply of Agri. Machinery & Inputs
3. Director Floriculture/Jammu/Srinagar. For supply of Agri. Machinery & Inputs
4. Director Sericulture Jammu/Srinagar For supply of Agri. Machinery & Inputs



5. Farmers for supply of fertilizer and other Agriculture Inputs.
6. General public for sale of Food items like Honey, Jams of different varieties, Dry Fruits and other local Agri. Produce.
7. Farmers, Cattle owners, Dairy owners for supply of ISI mark palletted cattle feed.
8. Farmers/traders for providing Cold Storage space on rental basis.


